Subject: Scrutinizer's Report u/s 108 & 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 for voting by Equity shareholders through Postal Ballot & Remote e-voting.

The Board of Directors of Wockhardt Limited (hereinafter referred to as the 'Company') at its meeting held on 10th November, 2016 had appointed me as the Scrutinizer for the Postal Ballot/Remote Electronic Voting pursuant to Section 108 & 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the 'Act') read with Rule 20 & 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, and other applicable provisions, if any, and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the 'Listing Regulations'), for the Resolution(s) in respect of the matter(s) as set out in the Postal Ballot Notice proposed to be transacted by way of postal ballot / e-voting.

Report on Scrutiny

- The Company had appointed National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL') as the Service Provider, for the purpose of extending the facility of remote e-voting to the Members of the Company through their website www.evoting.nsdl.com.
- Link Intime India Private Limited is the Registrar and Transfer Agents of the Company.
- The cut-off date for determining members for the dispatch of the Notice of Postal Ballot was 2nd December, 2016 (Physical & E-mail) and as on that date, there were 1,18,019 members of the Company. The Company/Services Provider had sent the Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and e-voting details by E-mail to 83,424 whose E-mail ID were registered with the Company/RTA. In respect of 34,595 cases, the Company had sent the Notice of the Postal Ballot, Postal Ballot Form along with self-addressed pre-paid postage in physical form by speed post.
- The Company completed the dispatch of the Notice of Postal Ballot through/by email and physical form to the members on 12th December, 2016 and 13th December, 2016 respectively.



- The notices sent (both through e-mail and physical form) contained the detailed procedure to be followed by the members who were desirous of casting their votes electronically as provided in Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time.
- The cut-off date for the purposes of identifying the members who will be entitled to vote on the resolutions placed for approval of the members was 2nd December, 2016.
- The remote e-voting facility was kept open from 14th December, 2016 (9:00 a.m.) to 12th January, 2017 (5:00 p.m.).
- As prescribed in clause (v) of sub-rule (4) of Rule 20 read with sub-rule (3) of Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration Rules), 2014, the Company also released an advertisement in 'Business Standard' in English language having country-wide circulation dated 14th December, 2016 and in 'Lokmat, Aurangabad', in Marathi language dated 15th December, 2016. The notice published in the Newspapers carried the information as required under the said Rules.
- The votes were unblocked on Thursday, 12th January, 2017 after 5.00 p.m. (IST) in the presence of two witnesses who are not in the employment of the Company.
- All postal ballot forms received up to Thursday, 12th January, 2017, being the last date fixed by the Company for the receipt of the forms, were considered for my scrutiny. All votes cast on NSDL remote e-voting platform up to 5.00 p.m. on Thursday, 12th January, 2017 were considered for my scrutiny.
- The postal ballot forms which are incomplete and/or which are otherwise found defective have been treated as invalid and kept separately.
- Envelopes containing postal ballot forms returned undelivered were also not opened and they are separately kept.
